DECISION

Acting on the basis of Article 10 (4) of the Feed and Forage Act of 22 July 2006 (Dz. U. [Journal of Laws] of 2006, No. 144, item 1045), Article 10 and Article 13 (1) of the (EC) Regulation 183/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 January 2005 laying down requirements for feed hygiene (OJ of the European Union L 35 of 8 February 2005, page 1) and Articles 104 and 107 of the Act of 14 June 1960 Administrative Proceedings Code (Dz. U. [Journal of Laws] No. 98, item 1071 of 2000, as amended), having considered the application filed by **Curtis Health Caps Sp. z o.o., Wysogotowo, ul. Batorowska 52, 62-081 Przeźmierowo**, dated 17 April 2013, the District Veterinary Officer

1. approves the manufacturing plant: **ul. Batorowska 52, 62-081 Przeźmierowo**
2. assigns the following veterinary identification number to the entity: **αPL3021012p**,
3. the entity will run a business activity consisting in the production of complementary feeds for dogs and cats in the form of capsules.

GROUNDS

On 17 April 2013 **Curtis Health Caps Sp. z o.o., Wysogotowo, ul. Batorowska 52, 62-081 Przeźmierowo**, filed an application with the District Veterinary Officer in Poznań, for approval of their business activity. Having inspected the manufacturing plant on 10 May 2013, the District Veterinary Officer in Poznań concluded that the manufacturing plant meets the veterinary requirements as per the (EC) Regulation 183/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 January 2005 laying down requirements for feed hygiene (OJ of the European Union L 35 of 8 February 2005).

INSTRUCTION

The Party is entitled to appeal against this decision to the Wielkopolska Provincial Veterinary Officer through the District Veterinary Officer in Poznań within 14 days from the service hereof.
